## VENDOR LICENSING TERMS & CONDITIONS

### I. AUTOMATIC DENIAL/REVOCATION

A. I understand that untruthful or misleading answers provided on my Vendor License application or in conjunction with any investigation regarding the status or determination of my vendor license is cause for automatic denial of the application and/or revocation of any gaming license granted by the Poarch Band of Creek Indians Tribal Gaming Commission (hereafter TGC).

### II. OBLIGATION

A. I understand that I have a continuing obligation to provide or allow to be provided all materials, assistance, or information requested by the TGC, including any information that may be requested from business owners, shareholders, directors, officers, or other key personnel; and to fully cooperate in any investigations conducted by or on their behalf. I further understand that if any information provided on this application changes or otherwise becomes inaccurate, or new information becomes available, I am obligated to promptly notify the TGC.

### III. RELEASE, REMISE, AND DISCHARGE

A. In consideration of the assurances by the TGC that no action on this application will be taken except after a complete investigation, I hereby release, remise, and discharge the Poarch Band of Creek Indians, the TGC, and their respective members, agents, and employees from any and all causes of action, suits, debts, judgements, executions, claims, and demands, known or unknown, in law or equity, which I had, now have, or may claim to have against the Poarch Band of Creek Indians, the TGC, or their agents or employees, arising out of or by reason of the processing or investigation of or other action relating to this gaming license.

### IV. VENDOR DRUG TESTING

- A. I understand that I may be required to submit to drug testing by the TGC without prior notice for either of the following reasons:
  1. For suspicion of being under the influence of drugs, or involvement in drug-related activity, while working on properties of the Poarch Band of Creek Indians.
  2. Due to involvement in an accident, or causing harm or injury to another person, while working on properties of the Poarch Band of Creek Indians.
- B. I further understand that if I refuse to test or test positive for the use of illegal drugs I shall have my license suspended for a six-month period. Continued licensing following the suspension period shall be completely at the discretion of the TGC. An illegal drug shall be defined as any substance prohibited by Federal, State, or Tribal Law, or substances not prescribed or used as prescribed to you by a United States physician.
